You must have:

- Minimum GPA: 2.3
- 4 years of English
- 3 years of Math (classes must be Algebra 1 or higher)
- 2 years of Natural Physical Science (1 year must be a lab)
- 1 additional year of either Math, English, Science
- 2 years of Social Studies
- 4 additional years of either Math, English, Social Studies, Foreign Language, Comparative Religion/Philosophy
- 1 year of English, Math, Natural Science

### NCAA Class Requirements – DIVISION II

This is important information for anyone wishing to play a sport at the collegiate level.

(as of August 2018)

You must have:

- Minimum GPA: 2.2
- 3 years of English
- 2 years of Math (classes must be Algebra 1 or higher)
- 2 years of Natural Physical Science (1 year must be a lab)
- 3 additional years of either Math, English, Science
- 2 years of Social Studies
- 4 additional years of either Math, English, Social Studies, Foreign Language, Comparative Religion/Philosophy
